Purpose:

The purpose of the Joan Keller Scholarship is to provide active Phi Theta Kappa scholars who have demonstrated servant leadership on campus and/or in the community with financial resources to help defray educational expenses for the Academic Year 2022 – 2023 while enrolled at a two-year institution.

Conditions of Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a Phi Theta Kappa member in good standing and currently enrolled at a two-year college in North Carolina, South Carolina or Bermuda with a cumulative GPA of 3.25 at the time of application.
- Part-time students, full-time students and international students are eligible to apply.
 - Applicants (1) must have joined Phi Theta Kappa and (2) must be active members (as defined by their chapter's Constitution) at the time of application.
 - Applicants must be enrolled at a two-year college in North Carolina, South Carolina or Bermuda for the academic year 2022 – 2023, taking a minimum of six credits per semester; thus, totaling a minimum of 12 academic credits within an ongoing program of study during the scholarship period. Courses for non-credit or audit grade status do **NOT** qualify in the total credits earned and attempted.
 - Applicants must have demonstrated servant leadership on campus and/or in the community.

Application Procedure:

- **Applicant** – An application portal link will be available to enable you to submit your forms electronically. You are required to complete Forms A-1, B, and C, and attach an **UNOFFICIAL** college transcript of all coursework completed within the past five years. **All applications must be submitted through the portal. There will be no exceptions.**

- **Phi Theta Kappa Advisor** – Complete and sign the certification in Form A-2. This may be done digitally as long as the form itself is sent from the Advisor's email address to the Alumni Advisor team at alphaomegaptk2001@gmail.com. Please CC the applicant on this email. Label the subject line with the applicant's last name dot first name dot jks (ie smith.taylor.jks).

➤ **Letter of Recommendation** – Two letters of recommendation are required (Forms D and E). The recommendation letter must address the topic indicated ([to be emailed directly to alphaomegaptk@gmail.com](#)) on this form. Please CC the applicant on this email. Label the subject line with the applicant's last name dot first name dot jks (ie smith.taylor.jks). No more than **ONE** letter of recommendation for each form will be considered. The recommendation letters and Forms D & E **must be signed and dated** by the author of the letter.

Application Deadline & Details:

➤ Completed applications must be SUBMITTED IN ITS ENTIRETY through the Portal no later than September 9, 2022 at 11:59 PM EST. If the forms are not **received in their entirety (i.e documents submitted to PORTAL and letters of recommendation received), it will be considered ineligible and will be disqualified.**

- All forms must be in document form or PDF.
- Do **NOT** attach resumes or additional materials.
